General information:

The seminar is held together with the EPIC Project Planning Seminar for students, and many activities are jointly with the students. Specific activities for the teachers are marked in **yellow** in this programme. While the teacher training seminar strictly extends only until February 12, we encourage everyone to stay until February 14 to help the students. As many are staying the whole week, we have added additional teacher activities also on February 13.

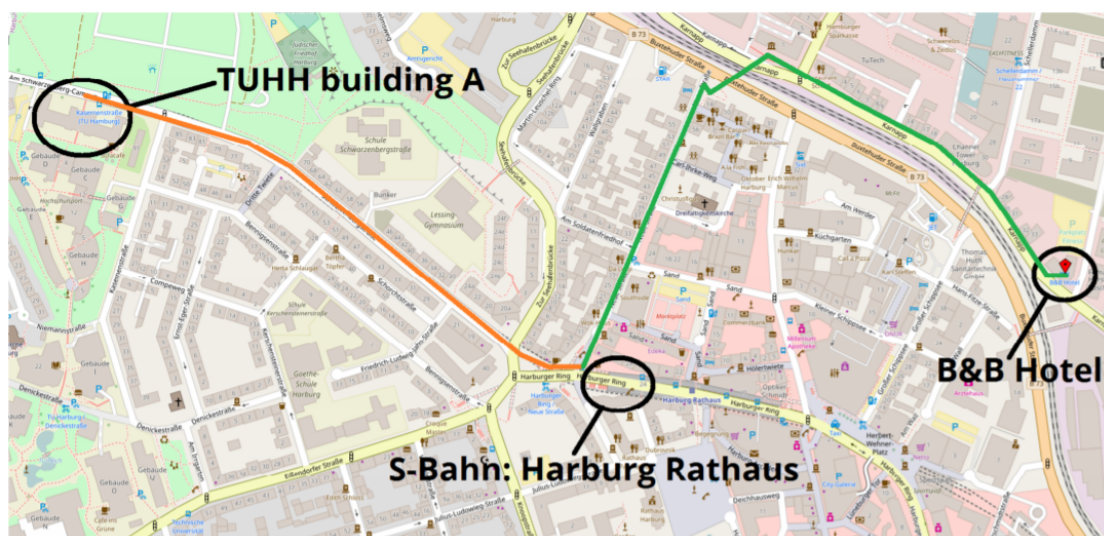
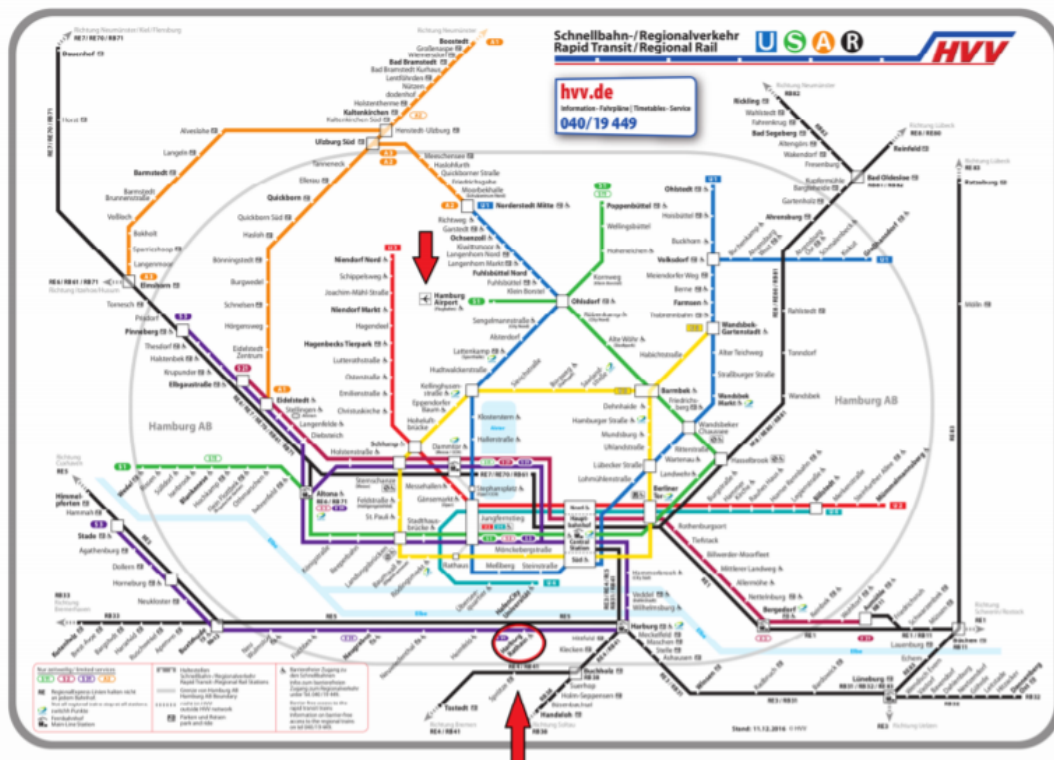
The Accommodation is in the B&B Hotel Hamburg-Harburg. From there it is a 20 minute walk to the campus building D, where lectures and projects are taking place. The address of the hotel is Theodor-Yorck-Strasse 1, 21079 Hamburg. See also: <https://www.hotelbb.de/en/hamburg-harburg/overview>. You will be staying in single, double and triple rooms. Bed linen and towels will be available when you arrive, so you don't have to bring them. Also, there will be free Wifi and a TV with Sky-TV in every room. The hotel is booked from February 9 (check-in) to February 15 (check-out). A complete room list will follow.

Check-in at the hotel will be possible from 17.00 until 22.00. If someone is arriving later than this time, please inform Jens and we will find a way to solve it.

Meals: Breakfast is served in the hotel. Lunch will be served in the university canteen, and dinner usually somewhere in the city (see the daily programme).

Arriving to Hamburg: When you arrive at Hamburg, the best and cheapest option to the hotel is to take the "S-Bahn". You take the S1 from the airport to "Hamburg Hauptbahnhof/main station". At the airport it's only going in that direction. At the main station (Hauptbahnhof) you have to change to the "S-Bahn" S3 or S31 (you have to change the platform) in the direction of Neugraben/Stade/Buxtehude or Harburg Rathaus. At **Harburg Rathaus** you leave the station (to the front right of the train) and walk to your destination. You might want to buy a **one-way trip ticket** (valid for one journey including train changes), which you can buy at the ticket machines at the S-Bahn entry. In Hamburg you don't have to validate your ticket, they are valid from the moment you buy them. In case you plan to stay the day in Hamburg and want to go multiple trips, you can buy a **day ticket**. There is a **group day ticket** for up to 5 persons which can be cheaper. All tickets are valid in U-Bahn, S-Bahn and bus. For train time tables and connections we can recommend <http://www.hvv.de/>.

Transport: The campus and accommodation are only a 20 minute walk from each other. When you are at the Harburg Rathaus S-Bahn station you should use the front right exit and follow the street Neue Str. until you reach an underpass behind the Lammertwiete street. Go through the underpass and just follow the street Karnapp until you reach the B&B Hotel on your left. If you want to go to the campus just go back to where you started at the Harburger Ring metro station. Now go to the crossroad Harburg Ring/Zur Seehafenbrücke/Eisendorfer Str./Schwarzenbergstrasse and follow the Schwarzenbergstrasse (up the hill) for 600 meters until you reach the main building A on your left.



The lectures and group work take place at the university campus in building D unless otherwise stated. Building A is the building facing the main road, see below how to find building D.

Wireless Internet at the campus – you can use eduroam, so make sure you have enabled your eduroam account. A guest network for people without eduroam will be (hopefully) available as well and announced on site.

Insurance: As a participant of EPIC, it is important you are covered by proper insurance. Please check what rules apply at your home institution. It is highly recommended also to bring the European Health Insurance card.

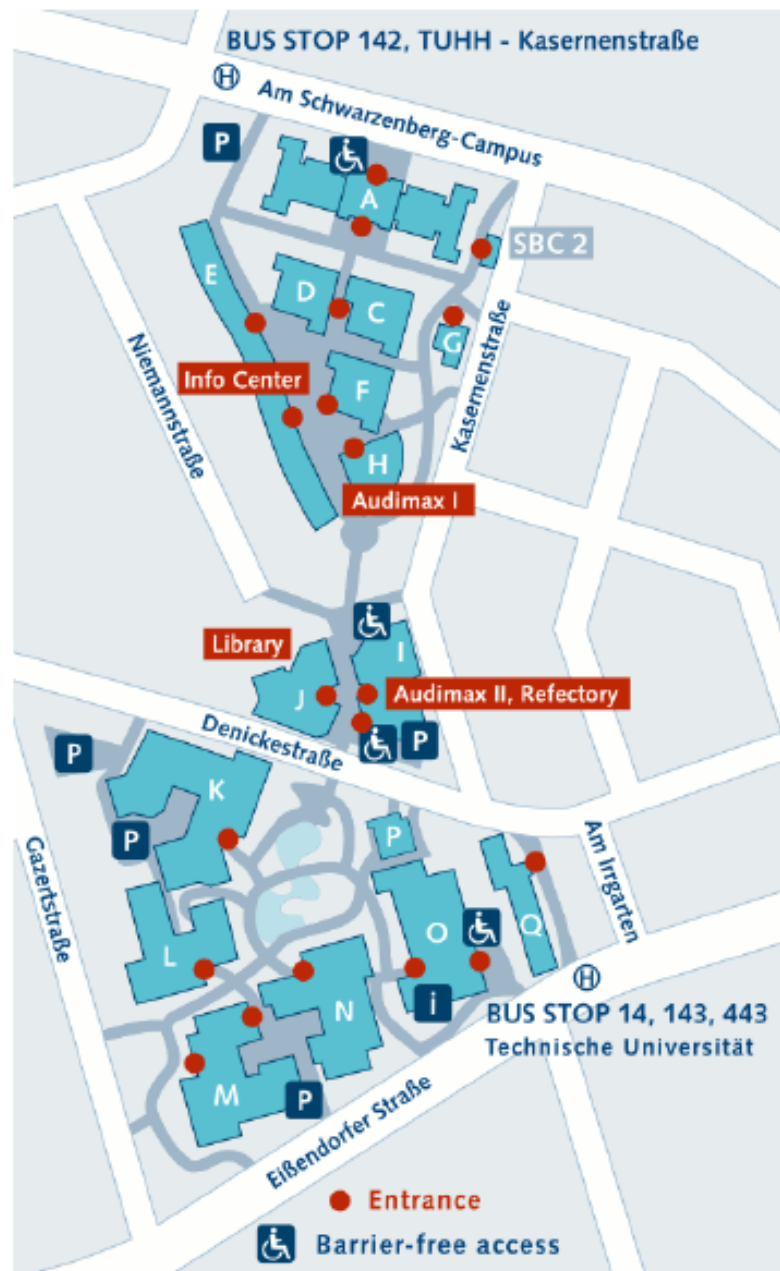
